Message from the Board

Welcome to great fall weather, kids back in school, and the absence (for now) of power outages. We hope that everyone enjoyed their summer, and have a new appreciation for air conditioning.

First, I'd like to thank Lyle Farmer, our Special Events Chair for organizing the Mother's Day Concert in the Park last May, and Marty & Eden Durbin for hosting the rain date for this concert in their back yard. Intrepid residents were not dissuaded from partying anyway on short notice.

At our October 14 General Meeting, in addition to approval of prior meeting minutes and the Treasurer's Report, we will have five items of business to cover:

- (1) Status update and, hopefully, reading the terms of settlement of the longstanding covenants enforcement action;
- (2) Voting to approve funding of "Rock Creek Hills Winterfest" as the third seasonal activity that our association sponsors;
- (3) Nominating Committee for 2011 RCHCA Officers
- (4) Q & A session with Chief Darien Manley and Deputy Director Mike Riley of Maryland-National Capital Park Police, Montgomery County Division. They will give a brief overview of Maryland National Capital Park & Planning Commission (MNCPPC) policies regarding park maintenance and usage, and address questions on how these may affect Rock Creek Hills Park in particular.
- (5) Brief Train Noise Update

Finally, a note about transitions. Every volunteer organization is only as viable as its members wish, and new blood is needed on a regular basis. If members value the activities and services that RCHCA provides, including having a louder voice than individuals can muster on their own for matters of local impact on the community, then it's important to step up to the plate and volunteer. After six years as President, I am stepping down as of January 30, 2011. Also stepping down is Mike Baker, our longstanding Secretary (with longer overall service than mine, albeit with a short

break in tenure). We know from remarks that people have made how much they appreciate our efforts over the years. Nonetheless, it's time to move on and for new volunteers step forward.

Cathy Ball has been appointed as Chair of a Nominating Committee, along with Hill Carter as the other presidential appointee. Other volunteers are sought to assist them in this work. The Nominating Committee is tasked with identifying RCHCA members who are willing to serve in the four officer positions specified in our Constitution and Bylaws: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Ken Sanford and Dave Hall have agreed to remain in the other two officer positions, but all officer positions require being nominated and voted upon, and competitive elections are welcome, even if such elections are no more common here than in the former Soviet Union. Even if you do not wish to volunteer for one of the open positions, please consider getting in touch with Cathy, Hill, or myself (Joe) regarding being on the Nominating Committee to seek out good candidates.

Train Noise Update: We are in the final stages now!

It's official; FRA has approved the Quiet Zone application submitted by the County. This was based on implementing an FRA-approved alternative safety measure (ASM), namely installing the lane separators (mountable median barriers). This ASM technology has been tested by FRA as having a lower risk index than the status quo of allowing the horns to blow regularly but without having this physical obstacle in place to deter vehicles from driving around the extended gate arm to "beat the train". County DOT still has various preparatory things to do, especially installing additional signage at the site and sending out the 21-day "Notice of Establishment" announcing the soon-to-be Quiet Zone. Barring unforeseen issues that are hard to envision, this should make the Quiet Zone a reality around November 1. Please remember that train engineers will remain empowered to blow their horns if safety requires it, such as sighting people or vehicles on or near the tracks where they shouldn't be. But soon the 60-times per day reality of train horns crossing at Forest Glen-Linden Lane will become a thing of the past.

I want to say a special thank you to all of the public officials and organization leaders involved in making this happen. A very special thanks is due to County Traffic Chief Emil Wolanin, who persevered with us for the last five of the 10 years this effort has taken. Among elected public officials, I'd like to extend a hearty thank you for invaluable assistance provided by Rep. Van Hollen; US Senators Cardin and Mikulski; State Senator Madaleno; Maryland Delegates Carr, Waldstreicher and Gutierrez; County Councilmembers Floreen and Ervin, and Kensington Mayor Fosselman. RCHCA members also should know that in getting our Federal, State and County public officials involved, it helped by partnering with eight other citizens, civic, and homeowners association; the Mid-County Citizens Advisory Board; and the Town of Kensington, all of whom wrote letters in support of train horn noise relief. This should be a lesson to RCHCA members on how to build a coalition of support around a community issue that extends beyond our immediate boundaries.

Rock Creek Hills Winterfest

On February 6, 2010, the first ever Rock Creek Hills Winterfest was held at the nearby Coffield Community Center. Most attendees agreed it was a success, bringing people out of their winter doldrums with food, drink, music and dancing, while getting to know their neighbors better. Although this event was largely self funded, people asked whether we might want to make this an annual seasonal event much like the Mother's Day Concert in the Park in the spring and the Halloween Parade and Potluck in the fall. The proposal that we'd like members to vote on is whether or not for RCHCA to fund expenses for renting a hall, hiring a DJ, buying food and non-alcoholic beverages only, and other incidentals (e.g., paper goods) totaling a ballpark expense range of \$1200-1300. People wishing to bring their own wine, beer or spirits are encouraged to do so, on their own.

Deputy Director Mike Riley has been a resident of Rock Creek Hills for 10 years. He is a licensed civil engineer, and has been with the Parks Department for 25 years. In the early 1990's he was involved with the construction of Rock Creek Hills Park at the site of the former Kensington Junior High School, which gives him quite a long term perspective on issues involving this park.

Chief Darien L. Manley has been a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park Police for more than 23 years, over which he has worked, supervised, or played a role in every section of the Montgomery County Division of his agency. Chief Manley has received numerous commendations and awards from the community, the Commission, and other public safety organizations, including national recognition as the APCO Public Safety Communications Center Director of the Year for the Mid-Atlantic Region. He has been a Maryland Police and Corrections Training Commission police trainer and Firearms Instructor for almost two decades, and is active in the Montgomery County Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee, Montgomery County Emergency Management Group, and Montgomery County Executive's Positive Youth Development Initiative Steering Committee.
